## **Routine Imaging of the Equine Foot**

algorithms in the radiographic system can be adjusted to compensate for most variations in tissue thickness. To generate the required image, knowledge of skull anatomy and topographic landmarks is necessary to insure correct positioning of the x-ray unit, cassettes, and horse's head.

Objective: To describe the anatomical relationship between sites of attachment of soft tissue structures of the equine stifle and their locations on standard radiographic views.

## **Radiographic anatomy of the soft tissue attachments of the ...**

For any radiographic view, the ideal exposure setting will depend on the equipment used (X-ray machine, screens and film, processor, etc.), the hoof mass, and the structure of primary interest.
