To become a legal permanent resident of the United States, meet with an immigration attorney to confirm your eligibility and help you prepare forms and documents. Next, have your sponsor file your immigrant petition unless you qualify to file for yourself. Then, fill out Form I-485 and submit it, along with the filing fee, to USCIS.

How to Become a Legal Permanent Resident of the United States

To apply for naturalization to become a U.S. citizen, you must: Be at least 18 years of age at the time you file the application; Have been a lawful permanent resident for the past three or five years (depending on which naturalization category you are applying under);

Sending your U.S. citizenship application and supporting documents to USCIS kicks off the process. The faster you can collect supporting documentation — for example, a photocopy of your green card (Form I-551, officially called the "Permanent Resident Card") — the sooner you can send these to USCIS, which can then begin to review your application.

How much does it cost to become a U.S. citizen? The current naturalization fee for a U.S. citizenship application is \$725. That total includes \$640 for application processing and \$85 for biometrics services, both of which are nonrefundable, regardless of whether the U.S. government approves or rejects an application.
