A randomized controlled trial compared a theory-based psychological intervention with a health education session in 114 participants. Dependent variables were fruit and vegetable consumption, intention to consume more fruit and vegetables, planning to consume more, and dietary self-efficacy, assessed before the intervention, 1 week afterwards, and at 6-week follow up.

Once experimenters recognize that RRO is not randomization, scientific experiments (whose purpose is a significance test) will be completely randomized while process improvement experiments (with more than one resettable factor) may still use an RRO because the number of process changes (representing the cost of the experiments) drops faster than the variance increases.
