How the Test Is Performed ... To perform the ANA blood test, sometimes called FANA (fluorescent antinuclear antibody test), a blood sample is drawn from the patient and sent to the lab for testing. Serum from the blood specimen is added to microscope slides which have commercially prepared cells on the slide surface.

§ 40.149 May the MRO change a verified drug test result? (a) As the MRO, you may change a verified test result only in the following situations: (1) When you have reopened a verification that was done without an interview with an employee (see § 40.133(d)).

(c) You must not transmit drug test results directly from the laboratory to the employer (by electronic or other means) or to a service agent who forwards them to the employer. All confirmed laboratory results must be processed by the MRO before they are released to any other party.
